

Instructions:

1. Students cut out the thermometer picture and glue to a piece of stiff cardboard. (If the cardboard is not cut to size, students can trim around the thermometer when they're finished.)
2. Students poke a hole at the top and bottom of the thermometer (at -20° and 120°).
3. Students tie a white piece of string and a red piece of string together. These can be pre-cut to about 8".
4. Students thread the ends of the string through the -20° and the 120° tie the strings together at the back.
5. Students can use the thermometer to show temperatures the teacher calls out.
